CATALYST 937 – Updated to add Build 1.0.3 JIRA tickets.

Perl_Lib 971 – Added new installer information.

Instantaneous SARB 977 – Edition2 MATCH files January – April 2013.

GGEO 978 – Code and ancillary files to repository for storage.

There were no issues identified, so these SCCRs will be approved.

CATALYST Testing Status

CM is waiting for Build 12.1 of the PR Tool delivery (SCCR 962). CATALYST and the PR Tool will be tested together before either is released. The PR Tool will be delivered in the next couple of days. SCCR 962 needs to be updated to include JIRA tickets.

Production Processing Status

May need a new PR for SSF Edition1-CV due to a CC change on *magneto*.

System Status

Proposed schedule for *AMI-P* upgrades is September 6 – 11, but this is not yet approved.

Two websites have been migrated to the new Web architecture. The rest of the websites will follow with a goal to migrate all websites by September 30. There will be three areas – development, testing, and production. A question was raised regarding the process of moving updates from development to production and how long this will take?

937 – Testing will continue after 962 is delivered.

919 – Finished running the validation months. No issues found other than the ones that we were already aware of when the software was ported to *magneto*. SIT testing can continue after *AMI-P* upgrades.

959 – No updates. Victor is focused on Edition4 now.

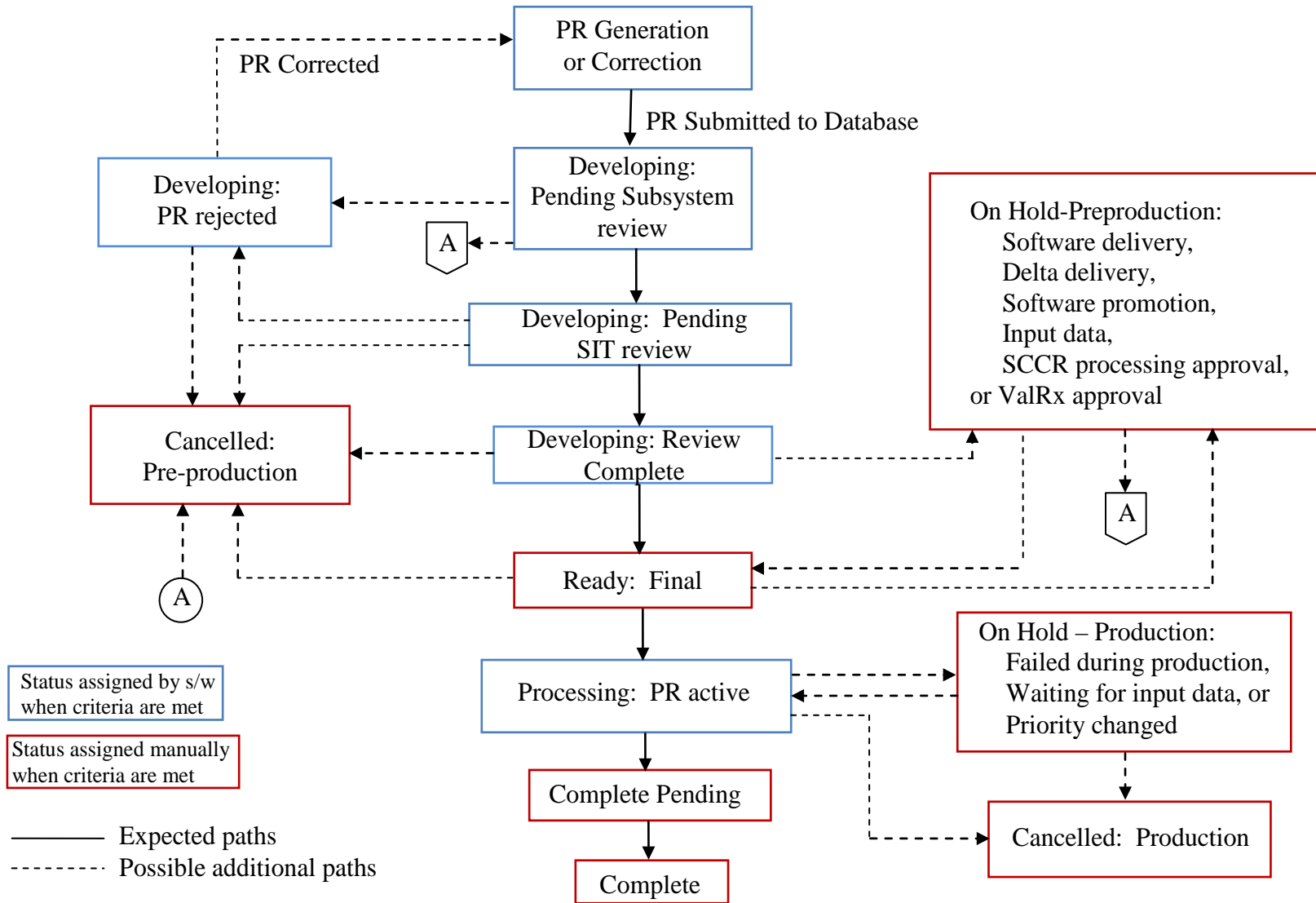


Figure 1. PR State Diagram

5	Pending Delta Delivery	Delta delivery of script or ancillary file needed
6	Pending Software Promotion	Promotion of delivered software pending

8	Pending SCCR Processing Approval	Last minute concerns / plan changes
9	Pending ValRx Review	When associated ValRx runs from a different PR are pending approval (should not be used on ValRx PRs themselves)

Status ID	Status	When to assign status
14	Failed During Production	Processing failed for repeated attempts and the cause is under investigation
15	Waiting for input data	Processing for all instances with input data is complete, but remaining instances are waiting for input data
21	Priority Change	PR not to process further until other higher priorities satisfied

Status ID	Status	When Updated	Who Updates
10	Ready - Final	When everyone agrees the PR is ready for processing	DMT Lead or Prod. Coordination
17	Cancelled – Pre production	Prior to beginning processing of a PR, if need arises	DMT Lead or Prod. Coordination
16	Cancelled - Production	After processing of a PR has begun, if need arises	DMT Lead or Prod. Coordination
13	Complete	Once all instances indicated by the PR that can be processed have been processed	Ops
